READING

This week in reading, we will work with our reading response journals as well as review fiction vs. nonfiction and the different elements of fiction. (5.RL.1, 5.RL.2.3)

WRITING

In writing we will be reviewing each component of the Simple Six writing rubric and focusing on what each one should look like when we write. (5.W.1)

HOMEWORK

Students will be responsible for the following tasks throughout their week:

- 1. Read 20 minutes each night.
- 2. Complete math packet by Friday. This week's packet will serve as a study guide for Friday's assessment. I will send home an answer key Thursday for students to check their work.

Students will also have a quiz over morning work from the week on Fridays. We will check all work together and designate 2 questions (1 math and 1 language) from each day that will appear on the quiz.

MATH

In math we will be working with decimals. Students will work on naming decimals in standard, expanded, and word form and comparing and rounding decimals. We will be having our first assessment this Friday over these topics as well as multiplying and dividing by powers of ten. (5.NS.3, 5.NS.4, 5.NS.5)

SOCIAL STUDIES

In social studies we will be learning about landform regions of the US and creating 3D maps to show the different landforms found in the US. (5..3.2)
